**A RESOLUTION FOR LEVERAGED FUNDS  
U.S. Department of Transportation  
2009 TIGER Discretionary Grants Program Application  
(Transportation Investment Generating Economic Recovery)**

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
The City of Durant, Oklahoma is submitting a grant application through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA) TIGER Program for Surface Transportation Infrastructure investments to construct proposed improvements, as identified below:


**Extend Enterprise Boulevard to 21<sup>st</sup> Street  
Widen South 9<sup>th</sup> Street (Business 69) - north end of Mineral Bayou Bridge to Main Street  
Rebuild Rodeo Road Bridge  
Improve Segments of University Boulevard (Washington Ave to 49<sup>th</sup> Street)  
Construct Pedestrian Bridge over 1<sup>st</sup> Street (Hwys 48 / 78)**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Durant is committing a minimum of 6.99% of the total budget costs in the form of local city budget funds, in-kind labor and equipment. In support of the 2009 TIGER Grant Program, a leverage amount of **\$1,502,500** will be utilized towards the **total project budget of \$ 21,498,110.00** contributing to economic stimulus for accomplishing successful projects; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, the City of Durant commits to a minimum 6.99 % local match in the amount of **\$1,502,500** towards construction, including demolition, relocating utilities and project administration, as part of the surface infrastructure projects.

**PASSED AND APPROVED** by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Durant, Oklahoma this September 8, 2009, at a regular scheduled meeting of the governing body, in compliance with the Open Meeting Act, 25 O.S. § 301 et seq.
