



WAIVER REQUEST

Per the TIGER Grant Federal Register Notice (Docket No. OST-2009-0115), an entity may request a waiver to apply for less than the \$20 million, if determined as a small region, state, county or city as outlined. The 2000 US Census data listed Durant's population at 13,549. With an estimated current population of 16,161, the City of Durant considers itself a small, but progressive city in Oklahoma. According to the Oklahoma Department of Commerce, the City of Durant is classified as a "Small City" eligible for special grant allocations set aside for cities ranging from 15,000 to 50,000. The City of Durant is therefore submitting a Waiver Request for a grant budget less than \$20 million to construct surface transportation infrastructures. The City of Durant is requesting grand funds in the amount of **\$19,995,610** to construct multiple roadway and bridge improvements, with a match contribution of approximately 6.99% match in the form of local funds, in-kind labor and equipment towards a successful project.


